



## NCCP Status Definitions

The following colors and abbreviations will appear on all Professional Coach Membership cards to indicate a coach's NCCP certification level. There is a Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) document regarding the card for your reference available on Members Only under Coaching – Professional Coach Membership Card – Question and Answer.

	<b>Can Skate In-Training</b> This coach is considering In-Training but not trained or certified and may instruct CanSkate <b>only</b>
	<b>Can Skate Trained</b> This coach is trained but not certified and may instruct CanSkate <b>only</b> .
	<b>Can Skate Certified</b> Certified to coach CanSkate <b>only</b>
	<b>Primary STARSkate Trained</b> This coach is trained but not certified and may instruct at the CanSkate, Primary STARSkate levels and above.
	<b>Primary STARSkate Certified</b>
	<b>Intermediate STARSkate/Provincial Coach Certified</b>
	<b>Level 3 Certified</b>
